Evansville MPO Transportation Improvement Program Amendment:

Public review and comment is being sought by the Evansville Metropolitan Planning Organization (EMPO) concerning a proposed amendment to the 2018-2021 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for the Evansville-Henderson Urbanized Area as described below:

The Metropolitan Evansville Transportation System (METS) requested the following amendment:

Des# 1601223 Lynch/Walnut Evening Service: Add operating assistance in fiscal years 2018 and 2019. Service costs of \$100,000 in each year will be funded with \$80,000 in federal Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) funds and a \$20,000 local match.

The proposed amendment will be acted on at the EMPO Policy Committee Meeting to be held at 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, March 8, 2018. The meeting is open to the public and will be held in Room 301 of the Evansville Civic Center Complex located at 1 N.W. MLK Jr. Blvd., Evansville, IN 47708.
