Evansville MPO Transportation Improvement Program Amendments:

Public review and comment is being sought by the Evansville Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) concerning proposed amendments to the 2020-2024 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for the Evansville-Henderson Urbanized Area as described below:

The Indiana Department of Transportation (INDOT) requested the following amendments:

- Des# 1702066 SR 62 Pedestrian Walk at SR 62 EB/WB: Bridge replacement project (Contract B-40560) Add Right of Way (RW) in FY2020 for a total of \$64,000. RW costs will be funded with 80% Federal NHPP funding and a 20% State match.
- Des# 1601011 US 41 Intersection with Lynch Rd: Intersection improvement with turn lanes (Contract R-39923) Add Right of Way (RW) in FY2020 for a total of \$20,000. RW costs will be funded with 80% Federal NHPP funding and a 20% State match.
- Des# 1592941 SR 161 From east junction with SR 62 to west junction with SR 68: Pavement HMA overlay, structural (Contract R-39380) Add Right of Way (RW) in FY2020 for a total of \$40,000. RW costs will be funded with 80% Federal STBG funding and a 20% State match.
- Des# 1801401 Various locations in the Vincennes District: Battery backup for signals (T-41254) Add project for Construction (CN) in FY2021 for a total of \$103,000. The project will be funded with 90% Federal HSIP Funds and 10% State Match.

The proposed amendments will be acted on at the Evansville MPO Policy Committee Meeting to be held at 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, November 14, 2019. The meeting is open to the public and will be held in Room 301 of the Evansville Civic Center Complex located at 1 N.W. MLK Jr. Blvd., Evansville, IN 47708.
