The Evansville Metropolitan Planning Organization has amended the FY 2020-2024 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to include/revise the following projects.

The Indiana Department of Transportation (INDOT) requested the following amendments:

- Des# 1900308 SR 62 Road Reconstruction from Rosenberger Ave. to Wabash Ave (Contract R-42287). Includes intersection improvements at SR 66 and Vann Ave, Burkhardt Rd, and Cross Pointe Blvd. Added project for Preliminary Engineering (PE) in fiscal year (FY) 2020 for a total of \$7,018,880, Right-of-Way (RW) in FY2023 for a total of \$300,000, and Construction (CN) in FY2024 for a total of \$55,360,441. The project will be funded with 80% Federal National Highway Performance Program (NHPP) Funds and 20% State Match.
- Des# 1900099 I-64 Bridge Deck Replacement over abandoned N & S Railroad, 0.82 mi E SR-65 (Contract B-42187). Added project for PE in FY2020 for a total of \$313,600, PE in FY2023 for a total of \$20,000 and CN in FY2024 for a total of \$2,554,820. The project will be funded with 90% Federal NHPP Funds and 10% State Match.
- Des# 1900273 US 41 Small Structure Replacement 1.80 mi N Jct SR-57 (Contract B-42185). Added project for PE in FY2020 for a total of \$368,200, PE in FY2023 for a total of \$60,000 and CN in FY2024 for a total of \$2,536,404. The project will be funded with 80% Federal NHPP Funds and 20% State Match.
- Des# 1900772 Bridge Thin Deck Overlay at various locations on US 41, I-69, and SR 61 (Contract B-42109). Added Project for CN in FY2022 for a total of \$3,520,000. The project will be funded with 80% Federal NHPP Funds and 20% State Match.
- Des# 1900540 Bridge Painting at various locations on SR 57 and I-69 (Contract B-42145). Added Project for CN in FY2021 for a total of \$1,457,000. The project will be funded with 80% Federal NHPP Funds and 20% State Match.
- Des# 1900115 SR 161 Replace Superstructure over Coles Creek, 0.69 mi N SR-62 (Contract B-42186). Added project for PE in FY2020 for a total of \$200,640, and CN in FY2024 for a total of \$1,591,323. The project will be funded with 80% Federal NHPP Funds and 20% State match. .

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
Des# 1900563 SR 62 PCCP Cleaning and Sealing Joints from 0.25 mi E of I-69 to W Jct SR-61 (Contract R-42124). Added project for PE in FY2020 for a total of \$383,100, and CN in FY2022 for a total of \$3,843,500. The project will be funded with 80% Federal NHPP Funds and 20% State Match.

Des#1900562 I-64 Surface Treatment from 0.13 mi E of SR-61 to 1.91 mi W of SR-161 (Contract R-42137). Added Project for CN in FY2022 for a total of \$6,020,000. The project will be funded with 90% Federal NHPP Funds and 10% State Match.

RESOLUTION NO. 20-24 TIP-01

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AN AMENDMENT TO THE EVANSVILLE METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION'S FY 2020 - 2024 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Evansville Metropolitan Planning Organization is the organization designated by the Governor as the Metropolitan Planning Organization responsible, together with the State, for carrying out the provisions of 23 U.S.C. 134 (Federal-Aid Highway planning requirements), and capable of meeting the requirements of 49 U.S.C. 5303 (Federal Transit planning requirements) in the Evansville Urbanized Area; and

WHEREAS, the Policy Committee is the policy body of the Evansville Metropolitan Planning Organization; and

WHEREAS, all federally funded highway and transit improvements within the MPO planning area must be included in the MPO Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) prior to the expenditure of federal funds; and

WHEREAS, the MPO Public Participation Plan does not require a separate public involvement meeting for TIP amendments, and the public participation procedure was followed; and

WHEREAS, this amendment will result in a TIP that remains fiscally constrained; and

WHEREAS, any changes to Kentucky non-dedicated funds projects have been requested by KYTC. The required funds will become part of the KY STIP end of fiscal year "fiscal constraint" recalculations; and

WHEREAS, the Policy Committee of the Evansville Metropolitan Planning Organization from time to time amends its TIP;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, that the Evansville Metropolitan Planning Organization's FY 2020 – 2024 Transportation Improvement Program is amended as follows:

- Des# 1900308 SR 62 Road Reconstruction from Rosenberger Ave. to Wabash Ave (Contract R-42287).
