*WHEREAS*, the MPO consulted with the Interagency Consultation Group and the agencies concurred in the MPO finding that the TIP amendment projects are within the maintenance area and are exempt, per 40 CFR 93.126 & 127, and there is no need to update the conformity analysis or issue a new conformity finding; and

*WHEREAS*, the MPO Participation Plan does not require a separate public involvement meeting for TIP amendments, and the public participation procedure was followed; and


*WHEREAS*, this amendment will result in a TIP that remains fiscally constrained; and

*WHEREAS*, any changes to Kentucky non-dedicated funds projects have been requested by KYTC. The required funds will become part of the KY STIP end of fiscal year "fiscal constraint" recalculations; and

*WHEREAS*, the Policy Committee of the Evansville Metropolitan Planning Organization from time to time amends its TIP;

*WHEREAS*, the MPO Participation Plan does not require a separate public involvement meeting for TIP amendments, and the public participation procedure was followed; and


