## **FY 2031 and Beyond Notice of Funding Availability for Indiana LPAs CY 2024 Call for Projects**

The Evansville Metropolitan Planning Organization (EMPO) will begin accepting applications for federal funding from Indiana LPAs **starting July 10, 2024**. Funds awarded will cover construction only and will be programmed for EMPO fiscal years 2031 and beyond. **Project applications are due Friday, July 26, 2024.**

Any project, regardless of anticipated FHWA funding source, is eligible for submission. Projects eligible for Surface Transportation Block Grant (STBG) funds, Transportation Alternative (TA) funds, Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) funds, Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) funds and Carbon Reduction Program (CRP) are eligible for consideration during this call.

Eligible applicants include local jurisdictions in the Evansville Urbanized Area in Vanderburgh and Warrick counties. Certain federal requirements must be satisfied in order for a project to be eligible for funding. Questions regarding these requirements may be directed to the EMPO.

The Call for Projects application, along with the accompanying Reference Guide and Budget Spreadsheet, will be available on the EMPO website **starting July 10, 2024**:

For this Call for Projects cycle, the application will be completed and submitted through an online portal. The Budget Spreadsheet is provided on the Call for Projects website for download as an Excel file. This should be completed and uploaded directly into the application. A Letter of Financial Commitment is required with the application and should also be uploaded directly into the application. Sample wording for this letter is included in the Reference Guide.

Once the application is complete and all supporting documentation is uploaded, the application will be submitted to the EMPO once the “submit” button is clicked.
