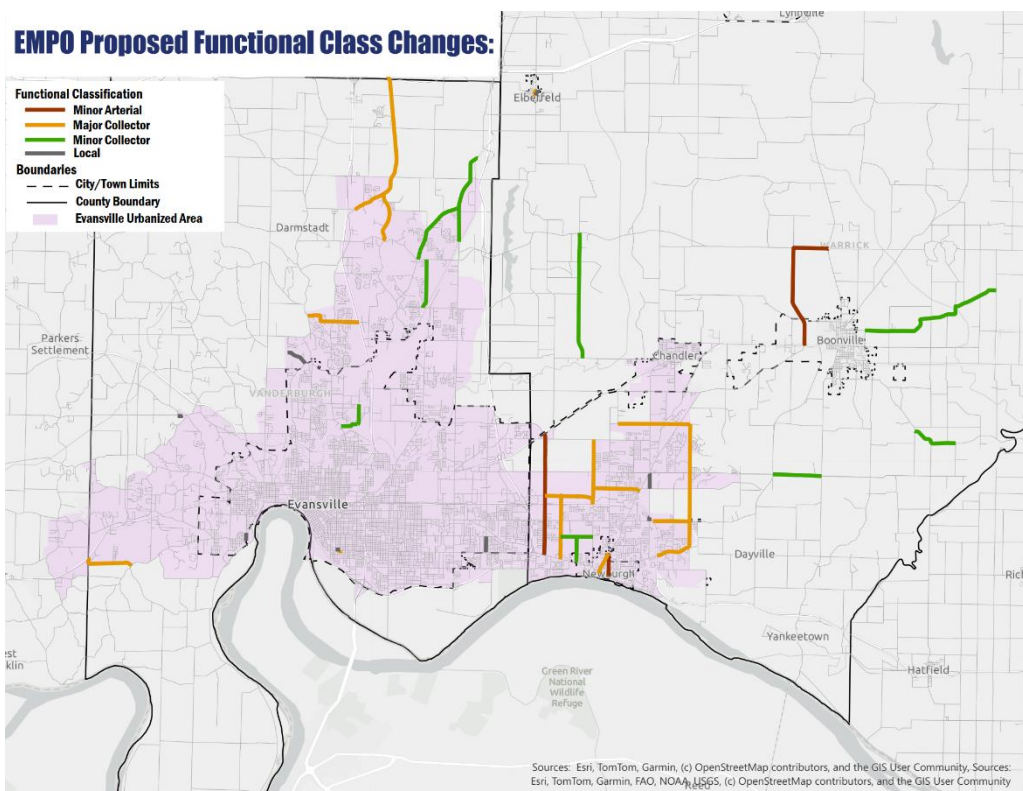

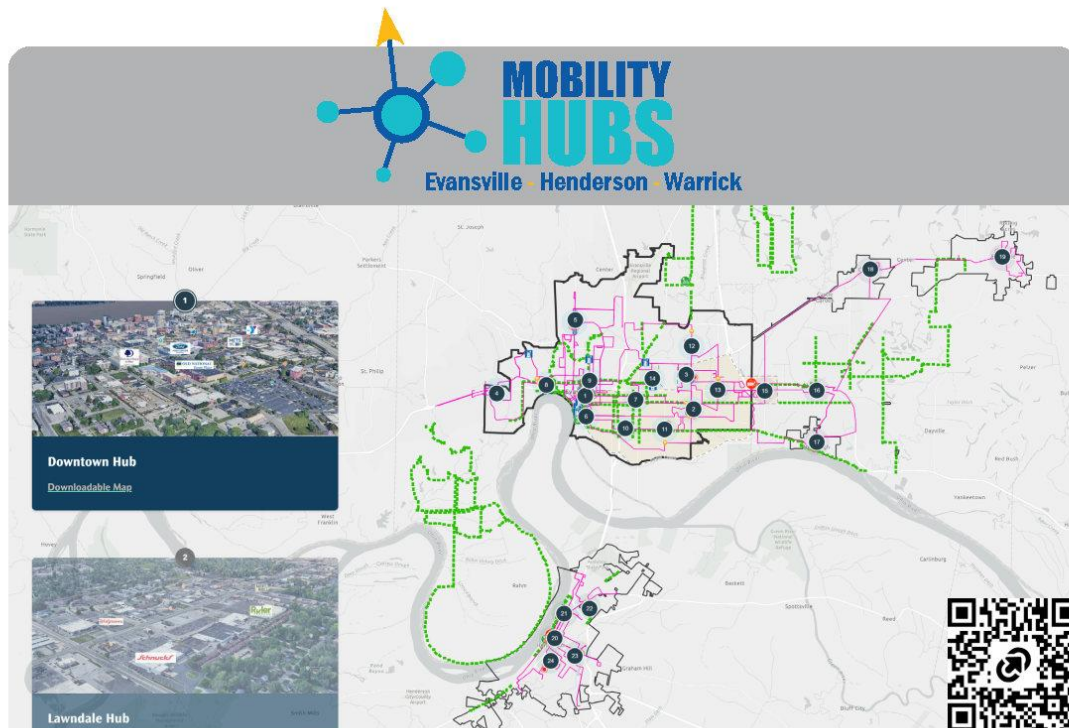

a. Mobility Hubs – presented by Matt Schriefer



What is a Mobility Hub?

A Mobility Hub is a neighborhood and/or commercial hub that includes a concentration of bus, bike, and pedestrian infrastructure.

What's Included in a Mobility Hub?

Think of it as a neighborhood center where the following come together:

- **Public Transit:** METS, HART, and WATS bus routes.
- **On-Demand Rides:** The METS Micro zone.
- **Pedestrian & Bike Paths:** Sidewalks, trails, and bike lanes.
- **Shared Wheels:** Upgrade Bikeshare stations and electric scooters.

Why do they matter?

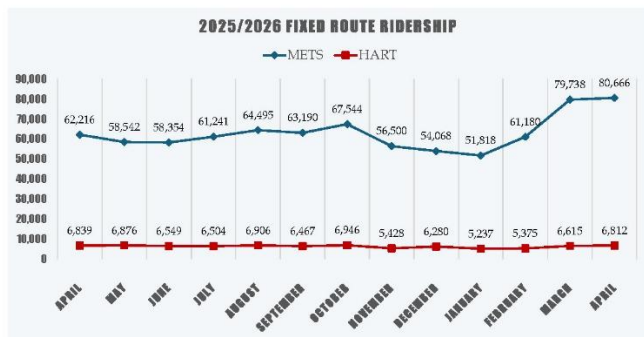
1. **Seamless Connections:** They make it easy to switch from a bus to a bike or a scooter without a hassle.
2. **Future-Proofing:** These spots are the priority zones for new upgrades, like better sidewalks, more trails, and EV charging stations.
3. **Regional Access:** The ultimate goal is to create a network of these hubs, allowing you to travel across the entire region without needing a personal car.

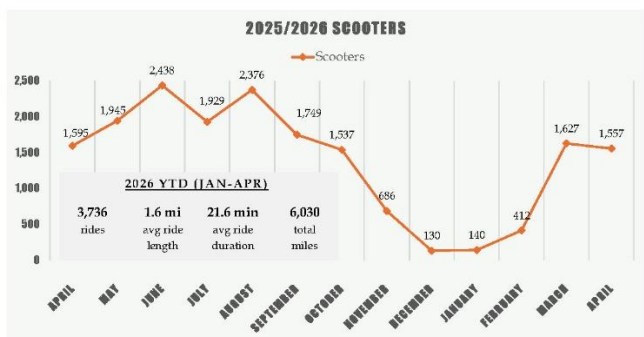
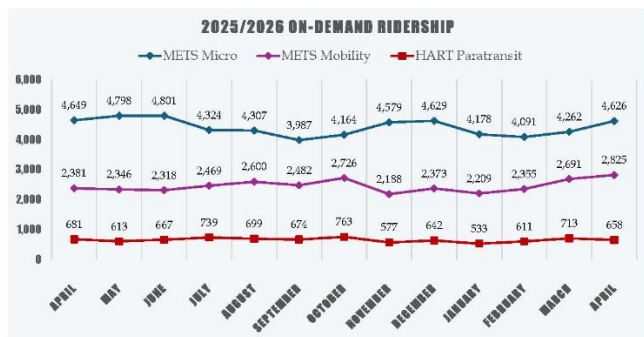

Matt Schriefer explained that the MPO is working with METS, HART, and the Evansville Trails Coalition to gather usage data monthly. He briefly walked through the data and the trends that are being seen. Matt also provided a flyer from the Evansville Trails Coalition that had more detailed bikeshare numbers (the flyer is on the next page).



6. PUBLIC COMMENTS

Erin Schriefer announced that within the next week or so, the MPO will be sending out a Call for Projects for Federal Highway funding for Indiana projects for FY 2032. This means projects will have to be ready to go to letting between July and November 2031. The application and guidance document will be distributed with the call announcement. Applications will be due back to the MPO in the first week of August. All details will be included in the call announcement.

Thomas Witt (KYTC) announced that KYTC recently completed the 2026 Enactive Highway Plan and it is available on their website. In looking at the plan, it looks like there are a few new projects in Henderson County, and some changes to existing projects. KYTC will be working with the MPO to update the TIP and MTP as necessary to reflect the new Enactive Highway Plan.

Kari Akin announced that Nick Hall (KYC) is retiring and that this will be his last MPO meeting. Nick Hall said it has been great working with everyone over the years.
